	Lesson Plan
We are going to learn to:	Create a bestiary.  Bestiaries are illustrated books that described a variety of animals, birds and nature.  Sometimes these animals were exactly like real ones and others are imaginary.
	Bestiaries were writen by scribes and illustrated by miniaturist illuminators from a monastic order. The bestiaries or "book of beasts" are hand-written codexs that compile different types of texts, from narrations to ethimological descriptions, about an inventary of real or fantasy animals. 







4) Now in each page choose your favorite animals and draw them like the example below


1st animal
